Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Bhutan (2225m)

Accommodation: Hotel | **Meal:** Welcome Dinner

When The traveler arrives at Paro Airport, our representative meets you then transfer to the hotel and check-in. When you are ready to explore Paro.

Day 2: Hiking to the Tiger's Nest (3120m)

Walking hr: 6 hrs | **Accommodation:** Hotel | **Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast drive to Satsam Chorten. Climb up 900m, takes 2:30 hours. The trail steeply uphill through the pine, oak and rhododendron forest. Tiger's Nest is known as Taktsang Monastery, built in the 17th century. This place is Padmasambhava had been meditating in the 8th century. It is located lap of beautiful Mountains. After visiting Tiger's Nest the trail down to the valley then Drive back to the hotel.

Day 3: Paro to Thimpu

Walking hr: 2 hrs | **Accommodation:** Hotel | **Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Thimpu is the capital city of Bhutan. Thimpu is 65km far from Paro. When you are ready after check in the hotel, then exploring around Thimpu city.

Day 4: Thimpu to Paro Airport Departure

After breakfast drive from Thimpu to Paro, then dropped to the international airport for your departure flight to your onward destination.
