

Muktinath Helicopter tour is one of a short and exciting trip in Nepal. This trip is designed especially for those who have very limited days for having the trip in Nepal but are wishing to experience pilgrimage tour primarily for those who eager to visit this holy pilgrimage site, Muktinath temple. Muktinath is one of the holiest pilgrimage sites in Nepal located in Mustang district, some 18-km northeast of Jomsom at an altitude of 3,749 m height at the Annapurna trekking range. The main temple here is dedicated to Lord Vishnu, Hindu deity. The word 'Mukti' means salvation and 'Nath' means god. It is a sacred place for both Hindus and Buddhists. Hindus believe that this is the salvation valley. Muktinath shrine or Muktinath valley is one of the religious places in the country. Hindus believe it as the place of Muktichhetra (the place of salvation) while Buddhists call it the valley of Chumming Gyatsa, in the Tibetan language it means the place of 108 waterspouts and believe that Guru Rimpoche (Padmasambhava) the founder of Tibetan Buddhism mediated here on his way to Tibet.

Muktinath Helicopter tour begins early in the morning from Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu or boards the flight from Pokhara. The flight takes you close to trans Himalaya and then finally land in Muktinath valley, then you will explore around the temple and monastery, have tea and coffee there and then finally get back to Pokhara, the picturesque valleys, where you can have a tour around the caves, amazing waterfalls, lakes, temples and have paragliding tour, operated from Sarangkot to the Pokhara and you also can extend your trip to Chitwan National park and have jungle safari trip or have rafting in Trishuli River and get back to Kathmandu.
